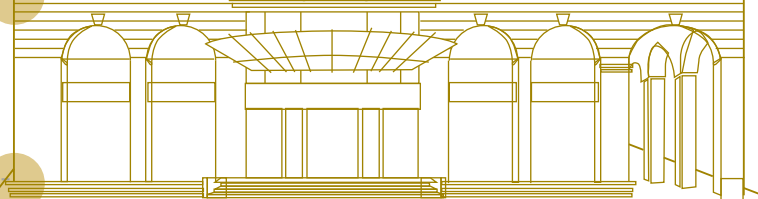

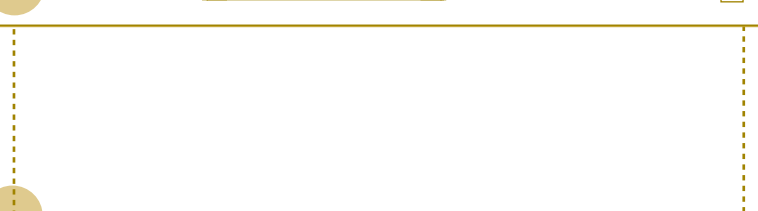

 “ZEUS”
 HALL
 (7th floor)

*Zeus, the leader of the ancient Greek gods,
 was always known as the God who controlled the weather conditions,
 he was keeper of the lightning & ruler of heaven, thunder & rain.
 He was the youngest son of Kronos & Rea,
 grandson of Ouranos (Sky) & Gaia (Earth)
 & was considered as the highest & most respected God in the ancient Greek pantheon.*



*“ZEUS” conference hall is located on the 7th floor,
 at the highest point of Mediterranean Palace Hotel,
 with an exquisite sea & port view.*

*It is regarded as one of the most excellent choices to host all kind of events,
 right in the heart of the city of Thessaloniki.*

*300 square meters without pillars,
 big windows overlooking the city’s port,
 blackouts, full sound system, wired & wireless high speed Internet access
 & 4 projection screens are some of the hall’s most important features.*

*The hall has a movable soundproof wall
 that helps separate it into two different meeting rooms of 150 square meters each.*

 (mezzanine floor)

*Posidon was the god of Sea, rivers & water in general.
 Son of Kronos & Rea, brother of Zeus,
 he used to divide his time dwelling between mount Olympus,
 the home of the ancient Greek gods & his palace at the bottom of the sea.
 Being the Sea god, Posidon had a gold chariot,
 with which he used to wander around the waves.
 On his presence, the waves sidestepped joyfully,
 while dolphins were playfully engaged around him.
 With his trident, he was able to cause heavy sea storm,
 but also instantly calm the waters down.*



*The impressive stairs of Mediterranean Palace Hotel,
 will lead you to the mezzanine floor where “POSIDON” hall is located.*

*“POSIDON” hall consists of “POSIDON A” & “POSIDON B”,
 86 & 54 square meters respectively,
 which are being separated by each other with a movable soundproof wall.*

*Natural daylight, blackouts, full sound system,
 wired & wireless high speed Internet access & projection screen,
 can be found in each one of the “POSIDON” halls.*

 Zeus was his father & Mia, one of the 7 daughters of Atlas,
 the giant who was holding the sky above the earth on his own shoulders,
 was his mother.*



*It is the smallest ball in Mediterranean Palace Hotel,
 located at the mezzanine floor.*

*The oval shaped ball, with glass walls (& blackouts),
 has wired & wireless high speed Internet access
 & projection screen.*

*With only 17 square meters,
 it is the perfect solution for meetings of up to 10 people,
 interviews, conferences secretary & product launches.*

 (ground floor)

*Apollon was the god of light, poetry & music;
 a healer & a clairvoyant.
 His parents were Zeus & Leto, the goddess of new life.
 Apollon, taught humans the art of music,
 singing & the art of poetry.*



*“APOLLON”, the 90 square meters ball,
 is found at the ground floor of Mediterranean Palace Hotel,
 with an easy access from the lobby.*

*The warm decoration of the room, the unique bar “The Hours”,
 which precedes the ball & hosts the coffee breaks,
 but also its proximity to the hotel’s restaurant “Diplomatico”,
 make the ball highly functional.*

*It provides wired & wireless high speed Internet access,
 full sound system & of course projection screen.*

*“APOLLON” ball can be connected with “Diplomatico” restaurant
 &, in its full expansion, it can accommodate up to 150 people for lunch or dinner.*

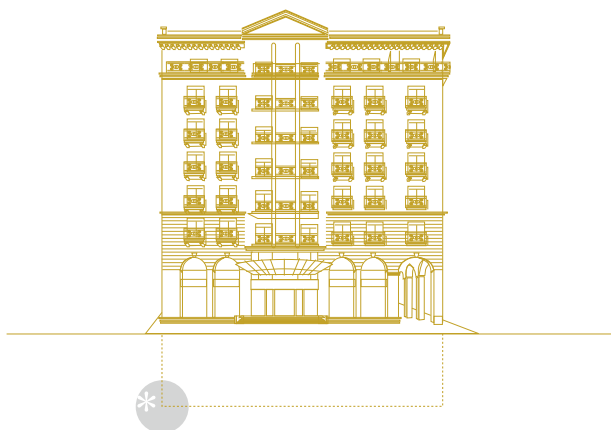

Princess Nafsika, the daughter of King Alkinoos of the Phaeacians and Arete, was well known by Homer's Odyssey. She was described by Homer, as a young & very cute lady, looking a lot alike goddess Artemis.



The 86 square meters' ball, located at -1 level of Mediterranean Palace Hotel, is perfect for seminars, workshops, product launches & meetings.

“NAFSIKA” ball has wired & wireless high speed Internet access, full sound system & projection screen.

By being right next to “IFIGENIA” ball, divided by a movable soundproof wall, it can be used as a single ball or in combination with “IFIGENIA”.

When used together, they can form a 203 square meters' ball, which can host parties, receptions, lunches & dinners.
